Code of Ethics for Students of the International School of Medicine "IUK"

The Code of Ethics (hereinafter referred to as the Code) defines the moral guidelines for the rules of conduct for students of the International School of Medicine of the “International University of Kyrgyzstan” (hereinafter referred to as “IUK”) based on generally recognized norms of ethics, morality, morality, respect to colleagues, the state and society as a whole.

The code is aimed at creating the most comfortable study conditions, a favorable psychological climate in the educational environment of the university.

The main goal of implementing all the norms of this Code is to strengthen the moral culture of the student community.

Each student of ISM “IUK”, fulfilling the norms of this Code, contributes to strengthening the image and business reputation of ISM.

A student at ISM "IUK" must abide by the Code while staying at departments, clinical bases, university grounds and beyond.

Basic moral principles of a student at ISM "IUK" of the Faculty of Medicine

The student in his activity is guided by the following basic moral principles:

- human attitude to people;
- respect for the rights, honor and dignity of the individual;

- decency;
- honesty;
- truthfulness;
- responsibility and fidelity to the obligations undertaken;
- integrity.

Basic moral standards and rules of a student ISM

Students of ISM "IUK", perceiving themselves as responsible members of the academic and student community, feeling proud of their belonging to it, must follow the following moral and ethical rules:

1. Norms and rules in educational activities

- A student of ISM seeks to gain in-depth knowledge in the professional field: the student is studying in good faith.
- does not miss classes without a good reason, takes part in the educational, research and social work of the university
 - The student uses all opportunities to replenish knowledge and acquire practical skills in the chosen specialty.
 - The student does not write off or use cheat sheets during grades and passing modules, passing control of knowledge, skills.
 - The student does not seek help from other persons during the certification tests, passing the control of knowledge, skills, suggesting individual performance of work.
- The student does not allow deception of teachers and administration of the University, does not use fake documents.

- The student does not use personal, family or official ties, does not offer bribes to teachers and administration to receive privileges in studies compared to other students.
- The student does not violate discipline during the educational process, does not distract other students from the perception of the material.
- The student abstains from using extraneous and distracting subjects from study (means of communication, entertainment, etc.) in practical classes and lectures, in clinical facilities and departments.

2. Norms and rules in personal behavior

The student's behavior in the ISM "IUK" and beyond must correspond to the high rank of a doctor. The student takes an example for his behavior from the best teachers of the International School of Medicine.

- The student respects the teachers and employees of the ISM, does not tolerate rudeness towards them. At the meeting, the student should greet the teachers and staff of the International school of Medicine. When a teacher enters the classroom, students greet him while standing.

The student follows ethical standards when communicating with other students. The student does not allow any form of humiliation of honor and dignity, physical and mental violence against a person, does not allow obscene, swearing speech in the walls of the academy and in clinical departments.

- The student seeks to create a healthy microclimate in the team, does not allow manifestations of discrimination of the individual on the basis of gender, social, national, religious and other grounds.
- The student shows respect for the customs and traditions of representatives of various peoples, takes into account the cultural and other characteristics

of ethnic groups and religious denominations, while in public places he must speak the official language (Russian), the exception is English-speaking students.

- The student must not be late for classes. The teacher has the right not to admit late students to the lesson.
- The behavior of a medical student must comply with all standards of medical ethics and deontology. At theoretical and clinical departments it is forbidden to speak loudly in corridors and rooms, listen to music, or run. During classes, the use of mobile phones is not allowed.

The student leads a healthy lifestyle and completely gives up smoking on the territory of the university and the medical institution where classes are held.

- The student consciously refuses the use of alcoholic beverages and drugs both in the ISM «IUK» and beyond.
- The student respects the traditions of the University, protects its property, monitors the cleanliness and order around itself. Outside the walls of the International School of Medicine, the student always remembers that he is a representative of the International School of Medicine and tries not to drop the dignity and prestige of the university with his unworthy behavior.

A student recognizes as necessary and useful all activities aimed at strengthening the system of student self-government, developing student creative activity (scientific, educational, sports, artistic, etc.), and enhancing the corporate culture and image of the International School of Medicine.

3. The appearance of the student

The student of the ISM must comply with the requirements for appearance during his stay at the departments, clinical bases of ISM, follow the rules for wearing a medical uniform by students of the Medical School of Medicine.

The medical form symbolizes the purity of the thoughts of the doctor, the severity in the performance of their professional duties. A neat appearance is always associated with good professional training. Hippocrates also pointed out that doctors should "keep themselves clean, have good clothes, because all this is usually pleasant for the sick."

The medical form implies:

- a bathrobe and a medical cap of white color, impeccably clean, ironed;
- interchangeable shoes with stable soft soles.

Wearing other hats in the premises of clinics and departments is not allowed.

Instead of a robe, a white trouser suit is allowed, provided that both items of the kit are used.

In addition to the medical form, the following requirements are imposed on the appearance of students:

- hair should be carefully tucked under a medical cap;
- nails are clean, short-cropped.

Do not use bright, voluminous jewelry and defiant makeup.

At the entrance to the ISM buildings and to the clinical facilities, the student takes off his headdress, takes off his outer clothing into the wardrobe and puts himself in proper shape according to the requirements of the ISM student's code of ethics. Lack of an established medical form (or partial absence) is considered a violation of discipline.

Wearing a medical uniform is regulated by the specifics of the discipline and the internal routine of the departments.

Students wearing clothing that does not meet the standards of an educational medical institution - tracksuits, shorts, short skirts, slates, and also other

provocative clothing is not allowed, as it contradicts the standards of medical ethics and is a sign of disrespectful attitude towards teachers, patients and future colleagues.

In catering points, as well as in public places, students should be in normal clothes, without a medical uniform, while observing the rules of behavior in public places.

The procedure for adoption, amendment and addition of the Code

- The student is required to know and abide by the Code. Ignorance or disagreement with ethical standards is not an excuse for unethical behavior.
- The code adopted is agreed with the administration of ISM “IUK” jointly by the student council of ISM.
- The Code is considered adopted if more than half of the participants in the meeting voted for it by open vote. This Code comes into force from the day it is adopted at the conference.

The code is approved by the rector and chairman of the student union committee.

- Amendments to this Code are made in the same manner as its adoption.

Responsibility for Code Violation

Deputy The dean for educational work, department heads and teachers are required to monitor students' compliance with the rules of this Code.

If this Code is not implemented, students are subject to administrative measures, the teacher has the right to prevent the student from taking classes. For systematic non-fulfillment by the decision of the cathedral meeting, the student is reprimanded with recording in a private matter and analysis of circumstances at the administration and at the academic council of the faculty. For repeated violations of the provision on the moral and

ethical code of the student of ISM "IUK". by the rector's decision, the student can be expelled.
