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1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1.1. The Debate Club "Brain up" (hereinafter - the Debate Club) is a voluntary association of students that develops tolerance, public speaking skills, logic, critical thinking and leadership qualities of young people.

1.2. The Debate Club is created in accordance with the Regulations of the ISM Student Council.

1.3. In their activities, the members of the Club are guided by this Regulation, other normative acts of the ISM "IUK", as well as the current legislation of the Kyrgyz Republic, the Regulation on the Student Council, as well as this Regulation.

1.4. The activities of the Debate Club are based on the principles of publicity, openness, consideration of the opinion of each member, free discussion of issues, collective decision-making.

2. GOALS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE DEBATE CLUB

2.1. The goals of the Debate Club:

2.1.1. development of talented and enterprising youth;

2.1.2. the formation of socially oriented citizens of society;

2.1.3. development of critical thinking, oratorical skills, communication skills of club members;

2.1.4. drawing public attention to the most pressing problems of the university, city, region, country, world and establishing business relations with leaders of different levels;

2.1.5. development of compromise solutions, potentially realizable in practice, to the discussed problems;



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2.1.6. free development of a creative professional personality, individuality, the ability of club members to defend their point of view, convince others, as well as the ability to admit their mistakes;

2.1.7. promoting social and professional self-realization of club members;

2.1.8. development and improvement of the game, development and testing of new formats;

2.1.9. active and constructive interaction with other debate clubs;

2.1.10. constant renewal of the membership of the club.

2.2. To achieve these goals, the following tasks are being solved:

2.2.1. development of interest among young people and society as a whole in the ongoing socio-political processes and economic;

2.2.2. the formation of political culture among the younger generation;

2.2.3. accumulation of experience and development of a culture of public discussion of socially significant problems;

2.2.4. development of the ability to speak confidently and beautifully in front of various audiences, to convince with arguments, the ability to think logically and correctly conduct a discussion.

3. ACTIVITY AREAS OF THE DEBATE CLUB

3.1. Activity areas are formed in accordance with the goals and objectives defined by these Regulations and the work plan of the Student Council.

3.2. The main activities of the Debate Club are:

3.2.1. broadening the horizons of the members of the Debate Club, promoting the accumulation of general educational and specialized knowledge about contemporary world, regional and local problems;



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- 3.2.2. additional education and self-education of the members of the Debate Club, as well as the acquisition of knowledge and skills in the field of PR, image and advertising;
- 3.2.3. developing a sense of empathy, tolerance, respect for opponents, the ability to listen and hear others, the ability to independently and collectively make decisions;
- 3.2.4. development of psychological stability, self-confidence, positive self-esteem;
- 3.2.5. development of the ability to see the positive and negative sides of any problem, the ability to think strategically, analyze the situation;
- 3.2.6. development of cooperation and relations between students and other youth public associations;
- 3.2.7. attracting new like-minded people to the Debate Club.

4. MEMBERS OF THE DEBATE CLUB. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS

- 4. 1. Members of the Debate Club may be students of the ISM IUK, voluntarily accepting the ideas of the debate movement, students of other educational institutions, as well as representatives of the school league in agreement with the league coordinators.
- 4.2. Members of the Debate Club can unite in teams to participate in debate games, tournaments, forums.
- 4.3. The rights and obligations of members of the Debate Club are based on the goals and objectives defined by these Regulations and the Regulations of the Student Council.
- 4.4. Members of the Debate Club have the right to:
 - 4.4.1. motivate young people to participate in the debate movement;



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- 4.4.2. develop and support youth initiatives aimed at developing patriotism, tolerance, leadership qualities;
- 4.4.3. in agreement with the leadership of the faculty, represent the university at games, tournaments, forums, as well as at other public events of this profile;
- 4.4.4. to form mechanisms for attracting young people to the diverse activities of the debate movement;
- 4.4.5. make proposals regarding the activities of the Debate Club and participate in their discussion and implementation;
- 4.4.6. receive information about the activities of the Debate Club;
- 4.4.7. freely leave the membership of the Debate Club on the basis of their own will;
- 4.4.8. elect and be elected to the coordination bodies of the club.
- 4.5. Members of the Debate Club must:
 - 4.5.1. know the present Regulation;
 - 4.5.2. act in accordance with the goals and main objectives of the Debate Club;
 - 4.5.3. take an active part in the work of the Debate Club, planning and holding events;
 - 4.5.4. comply with all decisions of the general meeting of members of the Debate Club;
 - 4.5.5. fulfill the requirements of this Regulation and the obligations assumed;
 - 4.5.6. timely attend meetings of members of the Debate Club;
 - 4.5.7. to be an example for others, to lead a healthy lifestyle, to do good to people, to show feelings of tolerance and respect for one's neighbor;
 - 4.5.8. to be responsible for their behavior and deeds, to recognize the equality of all people, to work to improve society;



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4.5.9. not to commit actions that violate these Regulations, the ethics of companionship, as well as actions that cause moral or material damage to the Debate Club, refrain from activities that contradict the goals and objectives of the Debate Club;

4.5.10 protect your good name and dignity of the Debate Club.

5. OPERATIONS MANAGEMENT AND STRUCTURE OF THE DEBATE CLUB

5.1. The governing bodies of the Debate Club are the Student Council.

5.2 The activities of the Debate Club are organized by its coordinator, who is elected at the general meeting from among the members for a period of 1 year.

5.3. The powers of the Debate Club coordinator extend to:

5.3.1. holding meetings of the general meeting of members of the Debate Club with a casting vote;

5.3.2. representing the interests of the Debate Club in the Student Council, in the administration of the university, as well as in front of the leadership of social institutions, clubs, associations, etc.

5.4. The powers of the general meeting extend to:

5.4.1 determination of the development strategy of the Debate Club;

5.4.2 organization and conduct of elections of the Debate Club coordinator;

5.4.3 determination of directions of activity.

5.5 The General Meeting is held at least once a month. At the request of half of the members of the Debate Club, or at the request of the governing body of management, extraordinary meetings and meetings can be held.
