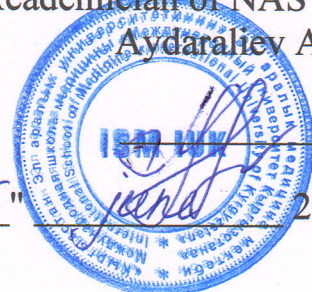

## Welcome!

We are delighted to welcome you to the International School of Medicine of the International University of Kyrgyzstan. For your safe and comfortable stay in our country, please familiarize yourself with this guide.

## 1. General Safety

### **Personal Belongings:**

- Always keep an eye on your personal belongings.
- Never leave valuable items unattended.
- Use locks and safes for storage.

### **Documents:**

- Keep copies of all important documents (passport, visa, registration) with you.
- Store the originals in a safe place.
- Make copies and keep them in electronic form.
- Write down and store emergency service and embassy contact information for your country.
- Create an emergency contact list.



## 2. Street Safety

### **Stay Alert:**

- Avoid deserted and poorly lit areas, especially at night.
- Walk with friends or in groups when possible.

### **Transportation:**

- Use only official taxis and public transportation.
- Avoid illegal carriers and suspicious offers.

### **Personal Information:**

- Do not disclose your personal information to strangers.
- Be cautious with social media and online contacts.





### 3. University Safety

#### Access Control:

- Always carry your ID card or pass with you.
- Follow the university's rules for access to the campus.

#### Medical Assistance:

- Familiarize yourself with the locations of medical points and the procedure for seeking medical help.
- Always have the contact information for medical facilities with you. (+996 997 103 002 - University Clinic "Amanat")



#### Evacuation:

- Study the evacuation plan in case of an emergency.
- Participate in fire safety drills.

### Traditions and Behavioral Norms:

- Kyrgyzstan is a country with a rich cultural heritage, where respect and politeness are highly valued.
- Be respectful to elders, professors, and university staff.
- In public places (transport, stores), it is customary to greet and thank others.

### Major Holidays and Days Off:

- National and religious holidays may affect the working schedule of institutions and transportation.





## 8. Financial Security and Payment for Services
